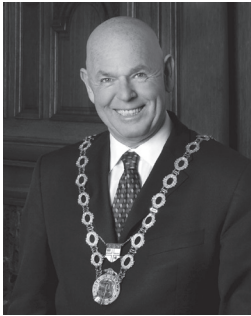

Can – Go Afar Foundation: Mission Statement

“Can-Go Afar is a humanitarian organization that aims to empower the ancient nomadic Afar people in the Horn of Africa to build a brighter future, by boosting awareness and advocacy for the voiceless, by providing education and literacy for the next generation, and by delivering health and food relief for the desperate. Together we will change the course of history.”

Quick Facts about the Afar:



- The Afar people live in the triangulation of Eritrea, Djibouti and Ethiopia (the Horn of Africa)
- The poorest among Afar people live in the desert, known as the Danakil Depression, which consists of a vast plain of salt pans and active volcanoes. Much of it lies 200 feet below sea level and has daily temperatures as high as 125 degrees F.
- Population is estimated to be 3 to 5 million
- The Afar triangle is home of Lucy, the oldest skeletal remains yet discovered (3.2 million years old).
- Life expectancy 45 years.
- 94 % illiterate
- 90 % nomadic
- Religion: Islam
- Afars in Canada: 1,000 (estimated)
